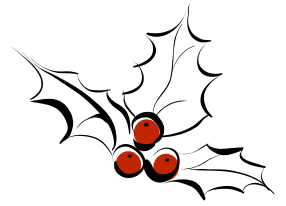


NEW HORIZON'S CHRISTMAS WISH LIST
